These are usually 30 min., Fri and Sat from 12:30-1:30pm. All member of the family, including dogs, are required to attend. Afterward, both parties email her as to their decision & whether they want to move forward in the adoption.





TABASCO: is an extremely sweet 4 year old Red Heeler Mix. When he came to the program, he had some skin issues, but it was addressed and he's good to go. Tabasco may live up to his name in the red color, but not in his temperament. He is not all hot and sassy. In fact, he is fantastic with other dogs, children, and every person he meets.
