SCCC's program is just one step (but a very important step) in a 24 month process to train and match these dogs.

- Puppy Raiser- socializing and health monitoring (0-7 months)
- SCCC Beginning Training- Teaches them "how to learn", basic commands, some specialized training for certain dogs, assessment of temperament, health monitoring. (7-18mos)
