ORDINANCE NO. 290

CITY OF KAHLOTUS, WASHINGTON

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO ADOPT FOR THE CITY OF KAHLOTUS, WASHINGTON, THE PROVISION FOR THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS OF INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM AS PRESCRIBED BY REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON 35A.11.080 to 35A.11.100.

WHEREAS, Chapter 35A.11.080 to 35A.11.100 of the Revised Code of Washington provides for the exercise of the powers of initiative and referendum as prescribed herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Kahlotus has determined that it would serve the best interests and general welfare of the City to adopt such procedure; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk published the Resolution prior to the adoption of this Ordinance in the Connell Graphic, within ten days after the adoption of the Resolution; and

WHEREAS, no timely and sufficient referendum petitions regarding initiative and referendum have been filed as provided for in Revised Code of Washington 35A.02.025 and 35A.29.170, within the 90 day period after the first publication of the Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KAHLOTUS:

Section 1. The adoption of the exercise of the powers of initiative and referendum as prescribed by Revised Code of Washington 35A.11.080 to 35A.11.100 will serve the best interests and general welfare of the City of Kahlotus.

Section 2. The City Council hereby declares its intention to adopt and abide by the laws of initiative and referendum as provided under Revised Code of Washington Chapter 35A.11.080 to 35A.11.100.


