ORDINANCE NO. 382

AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of Jameson Avenue between the east marginal line of the pavement in Third Street and the west marginal line of the pavement in Township Street, in the City of Sedro-Woolley, Washington, by laying and constructing in and along said avenue between the points above named, a concrete pavement and doing such other work in connection therewith as may be necessary, all in accordance with Resolution No. 63 of the City Council of the City of Sedro-Woolley, creating a local improvement district therefor, and providing the payment for said improvement be made by special assessments upon property in said district by mode of "Payment by Bonds".

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEDRO-WOOLLEY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Jameson Avenue in the City of Sedro-Woolley, between the east marginal line of the pavement in Third Street and the west marginal line of the pavement in Township Street, be improved by laying and constructing in and along said avenue between the points above named a concrete pavement twenty feet in width and that such other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to plans and specifications therefor prepared by the City Engineer and on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary and incidental expenses, shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created in accordance with law. The City of Sedro-Woolley shall not be liable in any manner for any portion of the cost and expense of said improvement.

Section 3. That there is hereby established a local improvement District to be called "Local Improvement District No. 60" which said district is described as follows:

All the property between the termini of said improvement abutting upon, adjacent, vicinal or proximate to such portion of said avenue to a distance back from the marginal lines thereof as provided by law.

Section 4. Bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum payable on or before twelve years from the date of issuance shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of this improvement, which bonds shall be redeemed by the collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed upon the property within said district, payable in ten equal annual installments with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum, under the mode of "Payment of Bonds" as defined by law and the ordinances of the City of Sedro-Woolley. These bonds shall be delivered to the contractor in redemption of warrants on the Local Improvement District Fund issued on estimates of the City Engineer, or the City of Sedro-Woolley, may at its election sell said bonds and make such redemption in cash.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days from and after its passage, approval and publication.
