
Acre Feet of Water Restored to Streams



- Restored water includes water from purchases, donations, or leases. The focus is on summer low flow periods and instream reaches where water availability is a limiting factor for fish.
- An acre-foot of water is one foot of water covering one acre of land. 35,000 acre feet of water is almost 11.5 billion gallons enough to support half the population of Washington for 1 year.
